

Which Kelly & Windsor alpaca quilt is right for me?

A good night's sleep is essential for well being and vitality. It is very important that you are not only comfortably warm during the night as being too hot or cold will upset your natural sleeping cycle and result in a disturbed sleep. The choice of the correct alpaca quilt is an important decision and will depend upon several factors -



- Climate Do you live in a warm or cold climate?
- Heating / Cooling Do you have room heating or air cooling?
- What type of sleeper are you? Are you a hot or cold sleeper?

Choose a lighter weight alpaca quilt if you are a "hot" sleeper or live in warmer climates and a heavier weight if you are a "cold" sleeper or live in cool or cold climates.

What are the features of alpaca quilts, pillows and underblankets?

Alpaca quilts are luxuriously soft due to the smooth surface of the fibre. This combined with superfine 100% cotton sateen casing makes our alpaca quilts beautifully soft, snuggly and whisper quiet. Lightweight and comfortably warm. Alpaca fleece has a semi hollow core and is very thermally efficient which means that the quilt need not be heavy to be warm. Moisture absorbent - keeps you dry and warm in winter and cool in summer. Natural and pure. Alpaca fleece is a very clean fibre and our quilts are manufactured without the use of environmentally damaging chemicals.

How warm are alpaca quilts?

Alpaca quilts are warmer than other natural fibre quilts, approximately twenty to twenty five percent warmer than wool on a weight for weight basis.



What about allergy sufferers?

Alpaca fleece is a very clean fibre and does not contain Lanolin, which has been attributed to
